Dear Valued Boikido customer,

The world wide toy market has been severely upset due to the recent recalls of RC2 and Mattel products due to issues of magnets and high levels of lead in paint coating that have created a level of panic amongst consumers and retailers alike.

Boikido spares no effort or expense in order to ensure that all Boikido products meet all safety and quality standards. We believe that it is every child's right to have toys that are safe and of the best quality available.

All Boikido products are sold worldwide and are tested to meet 3 major safety standards.

- 1) EN71 European standard
- 2) ASTM American Toy standard
- 3) ISO 8124 International standard currently adopted by Australia & New Zealand.

All paints are tested for heavy metals before production and are retested randomly from time to time to ensure that all necessary standards are being met. As a company policy no production is authorized without receiving the passed certification that is issued by SGS Hong Kong or SGS Shanghai who are internationally recognized testing houses.

Furthermore, all shipments are inspected by an independent quality control agency to ensure safe assembly of all parts. Boikido keeps on hand at all times all necessary documentation of the above safety certificates.

The Chinese government has recently issued a new law under which as of August 20th, 2007 all toy exports from China are suspended until each and every toy factory undergoes a thorough audit under which all raw materials, paints, QC facilities etc. are checked. Each factory can obtain an export license and resume exportation only after this audit has been conducted and the factory has been issued a passed certificate from the Chinese government.
